### **Lots of Pro-Liberty Winners on Election Day**

Of the 154 NH House candidates endorsed by the NHLA, 98 won their seats according to preliminary results (see [http://www.nhliberty.org/2008\\_endorsements](http://www.nhliberty.org/2008_endorsements) for the complete list). There may be some adjustments due to recounts over the next week, but it looks like we achieved a success rate of over 60%! Thanks to all who held signs, knocked on doors, handed out literature, and otherwise helped make it happen.

### **Donations Needed**

The NHLA PAC needs your help! This election cycle, we spent a lot of money helping out pro-liberty candidates for the NH House. At the Liberty Dinner, we funded all the incumbents and former legislators with A+ voting records. Then we spent all the remaining PAC funds before the primary on the A's, along with challengers who scored 100 on our survey. A successful fundraising campaign, including the Day at the Races, let us send out another batch of campaign contributions, mostly to challengers with 90 or 95 on our survey. In total we funded 95 candidates this year!

Finally, before the general election, we decided to take a hand in some of the districts with the best and the worst candidates, where the NHLA's endorsement might change the results. We prepared flyers flagging our endorsed candidates and sent them to the voters, either as newspaper inserts or in the mail.

Unfortunately, the PAC spent about \$1000 more than it had, so we need your contributions now!
