HB 516, relative to the time period for refiling a petition for annulment of a criminal record

HB 516

Judiciary: ITL 4-0

ANTI-LIBERTY: This bill would allow a judge to indefinitely deny the right to petition for annulment of a criminal record.

Under current law, a petitioner may refile a petition for annulment of a criminal record every 3
years. This bill removes that right by allowing the court to specify a time period after which the
petitioner may file a new petition for annulment. This provides the court with unbounded discretion
in limiting the rights of a petitioner.
