HB 1161 - Repealing the requirement to obtain a license to sell in order to sell pistols or revolvers at retail.	
Notwithstanding the Governor's veto, shall HB 1161 become law? Our recommendation:	YEA
This bill, which repeals an unenforced law that reduced personal responsibility, is <b>pro-liberty</b> .	

- In the committee hearings for this bill, it was noted by several people that few towns enforce ordinances regarding this.
- During testimony, it appeared that many chiefs of police were not aware of the statute.
