House Rules: Amend Rule 6-4

RULE 63

ANTI-LIBERTY: This rule change proposed by the rules committee would infringe upon the rights of legislators and citizens by stripping them of their article 2a right.

- This rule change would decrease saftey of those in the House by creating an unarmed victims zone in the House Chamber, anteroom, cloakroom and House gallery.
- This rule change would violate an amendment to the New Hampshire Constitution that was passed just 36 years ago.
- This rule change would disproportionately hurt the smaller stature and physically weaker members
 of the House.
- Rules should not supersede Constitutional rights. This is a slippery-slope that could erode other Constitutional rights at the State House
