# 2023 Liberty Rating

This is the annual Liberty Rating issued by the New Hampshire Liberty Alliance, based on 55 roll call votes in the House and 27 in the Senate. Individual grades for each representative and senator are based on pro-liberty or anti-liberty roll call votes and sponsorship/co-sponsorship for a subset of bills that have been included in our Gold Standard liberty voting guides distributed to Senators and Representatives each session day. Each bill/vote is assigned an impact score by the NHLA considering the degree to which the bill or vote impacts (positively or negatively) liberty.

**Pro-liberty bills** protect individual freedom of choice and personal responsibility; recognize the superiority of freedom over coercion; respect the citizen's right of self-ownership; promote governance that is transparent, accountable, and adheres to the Constitution; and recognize the value of voluntary economic decisions.

**Anti-liberty bills** replace self-governance with interventionist regulation; assume rules made by agencies backed by force are superior to voluntary choices backed by personal accountability; and assume a better economy can be managed by a central authority that compels people and businesses to pay for policies they may not willingly support.

The Liberty Rating is the result of hundreds of hours of work by many volunteers who have read and analyzed bills, testified before committees, called and written their representatives, worked on our other signature publication, the Gold Standard, and culled extensive data from legislative voting records. We encourage New Hampshire citizens to learn the facts about how their elected representatives are voting in Concord and to use this tool to hold them accountable. This report card serves as a valuable voter guide when these same representatives are running for re-election.

Motions of Ought to Pass (“**OTP**”), Ought to Pass with Amendment (“**OTP/A**”), and to accept a Committee of Conference report (“C of C”) pass a bill. If we recommended yea on these motions, it was a pro-liberty bill; if nay, it was an anti-liberty bill. Motions of Inexpedient to Legislate (“**ITL**”), **Table**, or **Indefinitely Postpone** kill a bill. Interim Study (“**IS**”) will result in the matter being studied and effectively terminates the bill for this legislative session. If we recommended yea on these motions, it was an anti-liberty bill; if nay, it was a pro-liberty bill.

Scores are based primarily on roll-call votes but also include a small modifier for sponsorship score.

## Legislator of the Year

The Honorable Josh Yokela represents district Rockingham-32 (Brentwood, Danville, Fremont).

He is a member of the Municipal and County Government committee and the Special Committee on Housing. He is a member of the Fremont Budget Committee and the Fremont Board of Adjustments.

He was first elected as a state representative in 2018 and he has received an NHLA Liberty rating score of A or higher for each session. This year, he was one of only five representatives to have a perfect voting score.



## Activist of the Year



Our Activist of the year is Stephen Nass. Stephen has had an impact on liberty in New Hampshire both inside and outside of politics.

He is the founder of the Free State Food Network, a voluntary, membership-based trade association representing the freedom-loving food industry in the state ([freestatefood.net](http://freestatefood.net)). This year, he published the Free State Food Freedom Guide. He hosts recurring liberty events including the monthly new movers brunch and movie night. He hosts a monthly seacoast preparedness group. He appeared in the NBC docuseries "Life, Liberty and Pursuit of New Hampshire". He coordinated testimony of 53 individuals in-favor of HB119, relative to homestead food operation licensure and making provisions for the sale of meat from uninspected bison, elk or red deer. This bill eliminated monetary caps on homestead food sales. There was bipartisan agreement in

both chambers that eliminating the threshold would remove a needless burden for home food vendors that sell non-hazardous food products prepared in a residential kitchen.

## Bills utilized for Sponsorship Score

Sponsorship score acts as a capped modifier on the numeric roll call score. Each bill that appears in the Gold Standard is considered for sponsorship score. Selected bills are assigned a raw impact weight. Anti-Liberty bills have the full weight applied upon introduction. Pro-Liberty bills receive 1/3 of the weight for each step through the legislature - 1/3 for being introduced in a chamber, 1/3 for passing in chamber that bill was introduced and 1/3 for passing in the other chamber. Co-sponsors each receive half credit while the sponsor receives full credit. Finally, the impact of sponsorship score is capped at + or - 5 points with the intent being to allow bill sponsorship to only have a modest impact on the final grade. Sponsorship score allows for legislator accountability even in cases where no roll call vote exists.
